
Chuck Yuska of PMMI recognizes Mario Carlomusto of Starview Packaging Machinery for 25 years of excellence as a PMMI member.

Soon customers began asking him to build things and the firm's first blister sealer was born. Today the company's product line includes blister and clamshell sealing, medical/pharmaceutical packaging, skin packaging and die-cutting, food tray packaging, thermoforming/vacuum forming, customized packaging equipment and systems with automation and integration.

"It wasn't easy," Carlomusto recalls. "It took hard work." However, the effort paid off. During the past five years, sales have tripled. "We do a lot of pharma machines," he notes. Starview recently just added a third CNC vertical machining center to increase capacity in its machining department.

Starview's machines are sold worldwide through a network of Authorized Distributors, who also provide service.
